Guidelines for Hobby Show:

- All entries should be dropped off in Ross Hall SUNDAY, January 29th from 4pm - 6pm.
- Use sign-up genius found in P & G (Tuesday, January 17th & Monday, Jan 23rd) to sign up for a 15 minute time slot to drop off your entry.
- Baked goods (only) may be brought in Monday morning from 7:30am to 7:50am.
- If you bring your item(s) in a box or tote, there will be space under the table for you to leave the tote during the day.
- With the exception of baked goods, if you are unable to drop off your entry on Sunday, a LIMITED number of spots are available to drop off on Monday morning, starting at 7:30am. These spaces are available by contacting Melissa Rodriguez at devilssnowflake5@aol.com, and are available on a first-come-first-served basis. We are sorry for any inconvenience.
- We will need parent volunteers this year, on Sunday afternoon from 2-4pm for set up Ross Hall and 4-6pm to help children with their entries, as well as on Monday morning 7:15 to 8:15am and Monday afternoon 2:15 - 4pm. Please see sign up genius in P & G.
- Parents may come in to pick up their child's entry starting at 2:15pm Monday afternoon.

• All entries, please read these special notes:

- If making a cake or other food submission, you agree to throw the item away at the end of the day. No one may take any food home, for sanitary reasons.
- If you have a movie or electronics showing a performance, movie, or other entry requiring electricity, please provide a source of power so that the item will show on a continuous loop throughout the day. Please provide an extension cord. We will locate your entry close to a power source.
- There will be no live performances. If you would like to show off your talent, please record a video of your performance and display it on an electronic device, on a continuous loop so that it will play throughout the day. (if you need help with how to do this, e-mail Melissa)
- Because of space limitations, please limit the size of your display to no more than 3 feet wide (36 inches by 36 inches)
